Here is the conjugation :

I am = je suis

you are = tu es

he/she is = il/elle est

we are = nous sommes

you are = vous êtes

they are = ils/elles sont

Examples :

1. He is a student. = Il est étudiant.
2. Pierre is kind. = Pierre est gentil.
